FUN DAY TOURNAMENT!

When: Saturday, June 13th, 2009, 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. (lunch 12-1)

Where: South Miami Taekwondo Main Dojo at 4542-B SW 75th Ave, 33155

Who: Any SMTKD member or guest. Anyone may compete with anyone else. Just find a partner, go to a ring and ROCK-N-ROLL!

Admission: Competitors are \$10 in advance, \$15 at the door. Spectators are \$5 if on the mat. Waiting room observers are free.

Event tickets: \$1 each. Each event will cost between 3 and 6 tickets. How many tickets you spend is up to you, but we recommend starting with at least 30 tickets. All Day Pass is \$89, \$69 per siblings. 1/2 Day is \$49 and \$39.

Lunch: We will provide an inexpensive lunch similar to last year. Cost should be between 2 and 5 tickets. We will also have our 3rd annual Fun Day Bake Sale running throughout the day! Get out your aprons, folks. For two years in a row, the fastest selling item has been Nicole Trujillo's fudge brownies- mm-mmm.

The Fun Day Tournament provides kids (young and old) with the opportunity to practice competing in a no-pressure, fun-filled environment. Rather than putting the focus on winning, all competitors will finish each event with either a first or second place ribbon. The competitor with the most ribbon points (explained later) wins the grand prize trophy. Everyone walks away with a fist full of ribbons and some serious stories to tell!

Any competitor may compete all they want with whomever they choose, including non-member guests. Using the ticket system, parents have control over how much they spend at the tournament. Please keep in mind that this tournament is a highly educational event as well as a fund-raiser for the dojo to help us through the lean summer months. We have put a lot of our own time, money, sweat and mental energy into making this an incredible event that your kids will love. Just take a look at our Fun Day poster at the dojo or ask any of last year's competitors. We (and your kids) hope to see LOTS OF ACTION!

Fun Day Events:

1. Flag Sparring: Like Flag Football, only SPARRING!
Take the other competitor's flag and WIN! * SWISH! *
2. Balloon Sparring: A balloon full of glitter is taped to both competitors' chest protectors.
Pop the other competitor's balloon and WIN! * POP! *
3. Egg Sparring: Both competitors carry a synthetic squishy egg on a plate.
Knock off the other competitor's egg and WIN! * SPLAT! *
4. Point Style Sparring: Old School, Karate tournament sparring.
First one to 3 points or whoever's ahead when the clock runs out WINS! * HAI-YAAA! *
5. Olympic Style Sparring: The same Taekwondo sparring rules as in the World Olympics.
Judges keep score and the winner is announced after the match. * *And the winner IS...* *
6. Forms: Compete with yourself or choose a partner or a group.
Ribbons awarded according to place or according to judges' score. * Choom - BI ! *
7. Board Breaking: Compete with yourself (and a board, of course). You get three tries:
Break the first time and get a Blue ribbon. Second attempt earns a Red. Third and final attempt gets White. * SNAP! *
8. High Kick Contest: Compete with everyone at the event:
At the end of the day, the competitor with the highest kick to body height ratio WINS!
(Wins a nice kicking target to whack on, that is!) * THWACK! *
9. Door Prizes: HOLD ON TO YOUR TICKET STUBS!
Throughout the day, if your ticket is drawn, win t-shirts, private lessons, rubber chickens
and God only knows what else! *?????*
(*You must be present to win - stubs with no name on them belong to the bearer*)
10. Trophies: HOLD ON TO YOUR RIBBONS! Blues are worth 3 points, reds are worth 2,
whites are worth 1: At the end of the day, the competitor with the most ribbon points per
event wins a trophy. And the competitor with the most overall ribbon points wins the
